- Tent & tent pegs/stakes
- Tent Broom
- Tarp for under Tent
- Sleeping Bags
- · Air mattress, Cot, Sleeping pad
- Pillows
- Bug Repellant
- Sun Screen
- Lantern
- Flash Light
- Folding Chairs (Handy around the campfire)
- Long fork or hangers for roasting marshmallows
- Small tools hammer, wrench

- Plastic cups, plates, utensils, bowls that you can reuse – "Green Camping"
- Coffee mugs
- Rain gear poncho recommended
- Sweatshirt and/or Jacket
- Hats
- Towels and washcloth
- Personal items & toiletries
- Books (Tree / Bird Identification or Other)
- Cub Scout Handbooks
- Camera & film
- Good Attitude:)

Pocketknife – **Only** Cub scouts who have earned their **whittling chip** and <u>are supervised by a parent are allowed to have knives.</u>

Camping Rules;
